FOR YOUR STAY IN THE COUNTRYSIDE

Check-in and Check-out

On the day of arrival, rooms are available from 2:00 pm.

On the day of departure, rooms must be vacated by 10:00 am.

Late check-out is available on request and subject to a surcharge.

Reception

The reception is open from 8 am to 7 pm. If you do not find us at the reception desk, please call us: we will be happy to assist you with any request!

Breakfast

Breakfast is served from 7.30 am to 10.00 am. (from 8 to 10 am on Sundays)

An early breakfast can be arranged upon request.

Please inform us in advance of any allergies or food intolerances.

Cleaning

Rooms are cleaned daily. Towels and bed linen are changed every 3 days.

Extra towels, blankets and pillows are available on request.

Equipment

All rooms are equipped with heating, air conditioning, TV and Wi-Fi.

A safety deposit box is also available in each room.

Behaviour

Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the rooms.

For smokers, outdoor areas equipped with ashtrays are available.

Failure to comply with this rule may result in a fine.

It is not permitted to remove any items from rooms or other areas of the agriturismo.

Any damage caused to property or equipment will be charged to the guest.

In case of malfunctions or if something does not meet your expectations, please inform us promptly so that we can resolve the issue as quickly as possible.

We would also like to inform you that we use amenities free from parabens and petroleum derivatives, and that separate waste collection is in place.

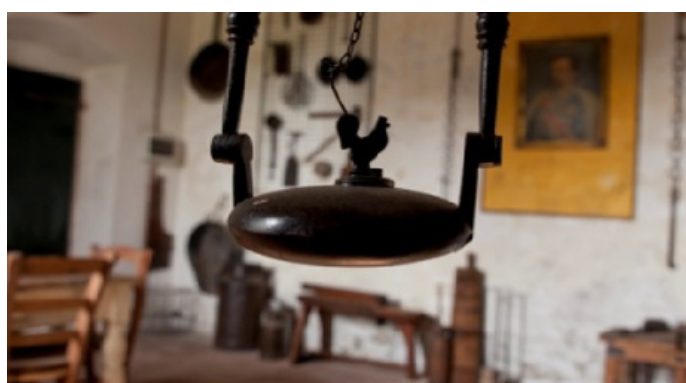
Outdoor areas (cascina and garden)

As the cascina is primarily a working environment, where potentially dangerous tools and equipment are present and agricultural vehicles may circulate, free access to all areas is not always possible.

Access to certain areas is available upon request, and guided tours of the cascina can be arranged by prior agreement regarding time and arrangements.

As the garden is a historic site **protected by the Fine Arts Authority**, we kindly ask guests to respect the environment, as well as the local flora and fauna.

For safety reasons, children under the age of 16 may access the garden only when accompanied by an adult.



PET AND ANIMALS

In our farmhouse, pets are welcome.

We kindly ask you to comply with the following rules, for the comfort of all guests:

- The presence of a pet must be communicated in advance and is subject to a supplement of **10 euros** on the room rate.
- Only small and medium-sized dogs and cats are allowed.
- Within the farmhouse, cascina and garden, dogs must always be kept on a leash.
- Pets must be well behaved and must not disturb other guests.
- Any damage caused by the pet is the responsibility of the owner.
- The use of bed linen and towels for pets is not permitted.
- Pets are not allowed on beds, furniture or tables, and may not be left alone in the room during the stay unless specific arrangements have been agreed in advance.
- Pets are not allowed in the breakfast room; however, if you prefer not to be separated from your pet, we can arrange breakfast outdoors or offer a suitable alternative.

CYCLING

The cycling routes in the Province of Cremona offer a different and sustainable way to explore the area. From Cascina Farisengo, you can easily access several cycle paths running along the Po River. Bicycles can also be rented free of charge at Farisengo.

THE ART OF NOUGAT

If you stay in Cremona, you should not miss its traditional specialties, such as mostarda, cured meats and, above all, torrone (nougat).

A symbol of the Cremonese confectionery tradition, nougat was first created in 1441 for the wedding of Bianca Maria Visconti and Francesco Sforza.

Discover and taste it at the Sorelle Rivoltini laboratory.
